

POPULATION PROTECTION PLAN

(INCIDENT NAME / DESCRIPTION)

PART TWO - PROTECTION PHASES / STATUS

ALERT PHASE

Public alerted to potential of public health / safety threat(s)

This stage will be implemented under the following conditions:

WARNING STATUS

Public warning that health/safety threat exists or is imminent. Contacts and briefings of persons within affected area(s). Protective measures recommended.

This stage will be implemented under the following conditions:

REQUEST STATUS

Occupants of the affected area(s) are asked to immediately comply with recommended protective measures **or** leave within a specified time period, by pre-designated route(s), and report to the evacuation center. Perimeter roadblocks are established.

This stage will be implemented under the following conditions:

EVACUATION ORDER STATUS

A disaster declaration or emergency proclamation has been issued and authority granted for the Incident Commander to order an evacuation. Access to the affected area is prohibited to anyone not authorized by the Incident Commander or designee.

This stage will be implemented under the following conditions:

MAINTENANCE PHASE

Perimeter roadblocks maintained and evacuated area(s) patrolled 24 hours a day. Regular incident status briefings provided for evacuees at pre-designated sites.

STAGE 6

Evacuees allowed to return. Hardship and special needs are evaluated. Briefings and assistance about continued need for protective measures provided .
