

Will there be shuttles available to pick us up from Ruby's Reserve Street Inn on Monday morning?
Yes. Call Kevin Erickson (406) 544-6484. He is coordinating crew shuttles from Ruby's Inn out to Lubrecht on Monday morning and back to Ruby's Friday afternoon. Ruby's Inn has a free shuttle to and from the airport. Workshop participants will be discouraged from renting their own vehicles to drive back and forth from Missoula to Lubrecht. It is a dangerous road in daylight conditions, much less at night or during early-morning hours.


I've already had S-232 and I am a DOZB or TRPB or HEQB. Why should I attend?
Our workshops present a modified curriculum specialized for a variety of heavy equipment.

Is there pre-work?
Yes. Participants should read Mechanized Equipment for Fire and Fuels Operations (2009).

What should I bring to the workshop?
Participants who are selected to attend should read their selection letter **carefully**. There will be a list of critical equipment that participants need to bring with them. Lubrecht Experimental Forest is in a remote location, so if participants fail to bring something needed for the outdoor sessions, they will not have a very rewarding experience.

What kind of weather should I prepare for?
October in Montana is typically quite mild. The sun rises and sets at 7:30 am/pm. Temperatures average in the middle 50s to low 60s, and precipitation is likely.
