	HAZARDOUS ACTIONS OR CONDITIONS	MITIGATIONS/WARNINGS/REMEDIES
ALL	PERSONNEL WELFARE -HEAT STRESS, DEHYDRATION, SUN EXPOSURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide cold water, brief on dangers of dehydration and symptoms of heat stress. • Provide air conditioned trailer space for breaks • Brief on predicated Heat Index
ALL	SEMI - TRUCK; PARKING, MOVEMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brief personnel on Traffic Plan, monitor truck movement, use one way control when needed, sign and staff as needed, provide appropriate directional signs • All personnel on taxiway/truck parking wear high visibility vests • Ensure ALL personnel and vehicles stay off of the active flight line
ALL	FORKLIFT OPERATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only licensed operators shall operate forklifts • Read and sign "Forklift JHA" • Inspect equip before operations • Separate operations from any foot traffic • Center loads, forks wide as possible , never exceed rated load capacity, keep work area clear of obstacles.
ALL	PERSONNEL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High visibility vests in work areas, no open shoes • Wear wide brimmed hats, in parking area, use sunscreen • Bug spray at night, fuel dispensing requires eye protection
ALL	COMMUNICATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cell Phones list updated daily in IAP, know radio frequencies for your work process.
ALL	LIGHTNING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The base Lightning Warning protocol requires all personnel to shelter in place in your vehicle or trailer. • Monitor lightning use 30/30 Rule you hear thunder 30 seconds after the flash take shelter, wait 30 minutes to resume, patrol truck parking area to notify drivers of lightning alert
ALL	DRIVING FS AND RENTAL VEHICLES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drivers of rental vehicles, must have federal drivers licenses, base policy no cell phones while driving • Drive defensively at all times, headlights on always, slow down in the rain and wind, watch for storm damage. • Watch for trucks, give them the right-way in and around the staging area, do not assume they see you,
ALL	LONG WORK SHIFTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide for worker rest 2:1 Ratio Supervisors monitor
ALL	INSECTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chiggers are in the grass, you can walk through but don't stay long, Ticks are present & may carry Lyme disease. • Mosquitoes come out at dusk thru the night, use bug spray, West Nile diseases is common in area.
ALL	HAZARDOUS MATERIAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It a military base, expect to find unknown materials, isolate, and notify appropriate personnel
All	FUELING REFRIGERATOR UNITS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fuel spill containment to base standards, proper grounding, have extinguisher on hand, tractor fueling will take place off base.
