The purpose of the After Incident Report is to identify issues that occurred on an incident and how they were resolved. The lessons learned in the report will also be used to refresh or update training curriculums. Issues and trends that are identified may have Information Collection Teams assigned to them in the future for further analysis and resolution.

1. What was the most notable success at the incident that others may learn from? *Excellent working relations with Mesa County.*
  
2. What were some of the most difficult challenges faced and how were they overcome? *The rough terrain on both fires made it extremely difficult to effectively use suppression forces. Through selective area containment, the team was able to herd the fire where desired.*
  
3. What changes, additions or deletions are recommended to various training curriculums? *Do not be in too much of a hurry to put people out on the line in difficult terrain.*
  
4. What issues were not resolved to your satisfaction and need further review? Based on what was learned, what is your recommendation for resolution? *We are still not adequately dealing with the local IA, VFD's and other local resources. We have not factored that in to the way we do business effectively. There needs to be an initial response training the works specifically with VFD's and other local resources to help educate them better in ICS and to further their understanding of the need to track resources on an incident.*
