This course is designed to meet training requirements for the SEMG position. Course content and examples are specific to wildland fire suppression activities. If students are expected to perform on other types of incidents, examples appropriate to the expected incident environment should be added. The course emphasis is on risk management, information gathering, management and oversight. From this standpoint, the course is applicable to any aviation management situation. Units include: SEAT aircraft makes and models, pilot carding and pre-use aircraft inspection, pre-use support/service equipment inspection, SEMG administration, logistical support/communications, SEAT operations preparation, demobilization and transition, field trip.
