Location: Saddle Back Fire, Warner Mountain District, Modoc NF, California

Date of occurrence: June 10, 2013

Time of occurrence: Approximately 1700 hours

Mission: Initial Attack.

Activity: Constructing Fire line to contain fire.

Number of fatalities: 1

Property damage: None

Narrative: While constructing fire line on the Saddleback Fire, Redding Smokejumper Luke Sheehy died from injuries suffered as a result of being struck by a falling portion of a tree. A local medevac helicopter flew him to a hospital in Alturas, California where he was pronounced dead. Smokejumper Sheehy, 28 years old, was based out of Redding, California.

The Saddleback fire started on the Modoc National Forest on June 10 when a lightning storm moved across the forest.

A Washington Office review team is in route to review the incident.
