On September 10, 2020 at approximately 1000 hours, a tractor, pulling a mower unit caught fire and sustained damage. At the time of the incident a small grass fire had ignited in the area. At this time, it has not yet been determined whether the equipment sustained damage as a result of the wildfire or if this is a separate incident. The tractor sustained fire damage rendering it inoperable. Other equipment was working in the area at the time of the wildfire.

Action Taken to Date:

As of November 02, 2020, a delegation of authority has been issued and an interagency Lessons Learned Review team has been assigned. The review team will be working both virtual and on site to conduct and complete the LLR.
