Subject: Firefighter Injuries, Dolan Fire: 72 Hour Report

Location: Dolan Fire, Monterey Ranger District, Los Padres NF, California

Date of Occurrence: September 8, 2020

Narrative: 14 firefighters were involved in a fire entrapment at the Nacimiento Fire Station on the Dolan Fire. Fire shelters were deployed. Four firefighters were medically treated, three of the firefighters hospitalized with burn and smoke inhalation related injuries. Two of the firefighters were released with one still in the hospital. All of the other firefighters were assessed and released. Nacimiento Fire Station was destroyed as well as various fire apparatus.

A learning review has been initiated by a Coordinated Response Protocol (CRP) Team. The CRP in-briefed with the Los Padres National Forest and the Dolan Fire Incident Management Team at 1330 on September 11, 2020. Interviews have commenced with more underway continuing the CRP process.
