**Description of the incident:**

The patient was an AD employee, 67 years old taking the Arduous Work Capacity Test.

The patient cleared his Health Screening Questionnaire (HSQ) and had his own physical exam two weeks prior to the WCT. During lap number 9 he wasn't looking well and seemed to be working hard. The WCT administrator and medical personnel on-scene were watching him closely. As he started the 12<sup>th</sup> and final lap he was short of breath and staggering. Medical personnel on-scene moved quickly toward him as he went down. They called 911 and had him transported to the hospital. It was determined that he had a minor heart attack.

The patient was kept in the hospital for a few days and then released.
